Collection location

- Most books are located on the **6th floor, South Block**
- All items available on open access will display the location CLASSICS, with the classmark prefix 3 eg CLASSICS South Block 6th floor (3) XFL P73T 2004
- Most periodicals are located through the Institute of Classical Studies, **3rd floor, South Block**
- Recent issues of periodicals are on display bays in the Goldsmiths' Library- **4th floor, South Block**
- Some items are held in the closed access stacks. These will display the location **Stack Service**. Please ask at Issue Desk, 4th floor or see our website for further details.
